At the age of 6 Phil Rowley was introduced to coarse fishing in England and has been hooked ever since. Phil has been fly fishing for over 25 years and has developed a particular attraction for stillwaters. His love of fly fishing has taken him all over North America in the pursuit of trout, atlantic and Pacific salmon, char, pike, walleye and numerous other species on the fly.

A former commercial fly tyer, Phil has written for almost every major fly fishing publication in North America. His contributions also include three books and numerous feature articles including two regular columns on fly-fishing and fly tying. Phil's first book Fly Patterns for Stillwaters has become a best seller. In addition to Fly Patterns for Stillwaters Phil has written Stillwater Solutions Recipes Volume 1, co-authored with long time friend Brian Chan and the recently released Stillwater Selections. Phil has filmed a number of DVD's including DVD Tying Flies for Stillwaters and 2 DVD's with Jack Dennis and Snake River Books. In 2007, Phil was a member of the gold medal winning team at the Canadian Fly Fishing championships.

In addition to Phil's shows and seminars he has had the good fortune to appear on such T.V. shows as The New Fly Fisher, BC Outdoors Sports Fishing, Sport Fishing B.C., Fishing Alberta and Fishing with Shelly and Courtney. Phil is presently one of the co-hosts of the New Fly Fisher, an educational fly fishing production.
