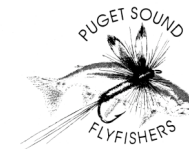


## **Hatches & Tactics for Streams and Stillwaters**

Rick Hafele has a Masters degree in aquatic entomology and a minor in fisheries biology, and has worked as a professional aquatic biologist for over 30 years. He has also penned the *Entomology* column for American Angler magazine for over 25 years.

Books to his credit include *An Angler's Guide to Aquatic Insects and Their Imitations* (with Scott Roederer, Johnson Books, 1995), *Western Mayfly Hatches* (with Dave Hughes, Amato Pub, 2005), *The Complete Book of Western Hatches* (with Dave Hughes, Amato Pub, 1981), and most recently *Nymph Fishing Rivers and Streams* (Stackpole Books, 2006).

Rick is also well known for instructional DVD's that include the 1983 classic *Anatomy of a Trout Stream* and more recently the four volume set titled, *Fly Fishing Large Western Rivers*, plus *Nymph Fishing Basics* (included with his latest book or sold separately) and the 2-disc set titled *Advanced Nymph Fishing*.
